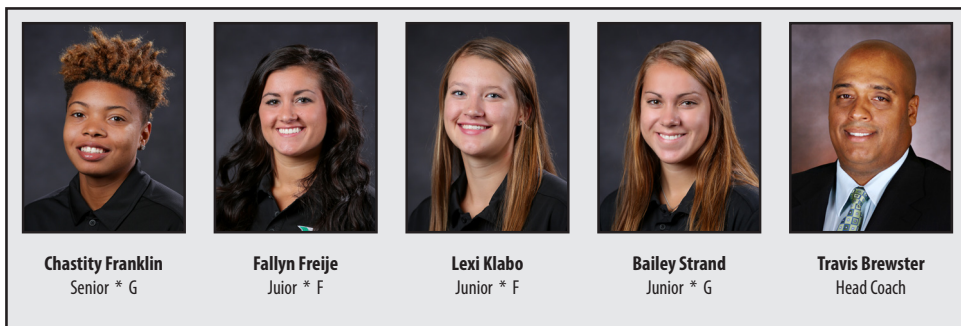

WHAT'S GOOD?

*North Dakota made its fourth straight postseason appearance and fifth in its NCAA Division I era.
 *No other Big Sky schools has qualified for the postseason in each of the past four years.
 *The Big Sky sent four teams to the postseason this year (Montana State- NCAA, North Dakota- WNIT, Eastern Washington and Idaho- WBI).
 *North Dakota had six different players score at least 20 points in a game last season (Makailah Dyer, Leah Szabla, Jill Morton, Samantha Roscoe, Lexi Klabo, Fallyn Freije)
 *Makailah Dyer etched 19 career games with 20+ points, eight last year (most in her career).
 *Dyer is into the top 15 list in scoring at UND (1,466), passing former teammate Mia Loyd and into 13th place.
 *Leah Szabla became the 35th in UND history to reach 1,000 career points in the win at Sacramento State Mar. 1. She is the sixth player in UND's Big Sky era to etch 1,000.
 *Lexi Klabo was second in the Big Sky in rebounding (8.3) and field goal percentage (.548) last season.
 *UND finished with an RPI of 129. It marked the third year out of the last four finishing at that mark or better with an average of 123 in that four-year span.

TRIO OF FIGHTING HAWKS HONORED BY THE BIG SKY CONFERENCE

Senior Makailah Dyer was a unanimous selection on the first team while sophomores Lexi Klabo (2nd team) and Fallyn Freije (honorable mention) also earned accolades for the co-regular season champions. The three honorees are the most for UND in its five seasons in the Big Sky and was tied for the most of any league school this season. North Dakota has now had a 1st team honoree in each of the past four seasons (Dyer, Madi Buck, Mia Loyd twice).

DYER, DYER PANTS ON FIRE

Makailah Dyer earned the Big Sky Conference's Player of the Week for a second straight time after her performance in UND's Feb. 25 win over Northern Colorado. The senior dropped 17 points and added a career-high 11 rebounds to etch her first double-double in the win.

DIRTY THIRTY

Makailah Dyer's 30-point career-high outburst in the Feb. 18 win vs. Weber State marked the first 30-point game for a UND player since Dec. 14, 2013 vs. North Dakota State, a 37-point barrage from Madi Buck.

SATURDAYYYYYY IN THE PARK

UND was a ridiculous 10-1 in Saturday games- last season after a 75-68 win over Northern Colorado on Feb. 25. In Coach Brewster's tenure, UND sports a 42-25 (.627) mark on Saturdays.

CASH ME OUSSIDE, HOW BOW DAH?

UND had out-shot its opponent from the three-point line (by percentage) down the stretch, posting a better percentage or equal in 12 straight consecutive games until its Big Sky quarterfinal loss to Portland State. In that stretch, North Dakota shot 35% or better from deep seven times and held its opponent to 30% or under 30% in seven of those contests.

DOUBLE BREW

Head coach Travis Brewster picked up his second Big Sky Conference Coach of the Year honor, following his 2014 accolade. Brewster becomes the first coach without the No. 1 seed to be named the top coach by his peers since the award was shared back in 2011. The fifth-year man has led UND to 89 overall wins combined, including a league-best 52 conference wins over the last four season.

NAIL BITERS

UND had a flair for the dramatic, playing 11 games decided by five points or fewer in '16-17. In those situations, North Dakota was an impressive 8-3. Eight of UND's league games were decided by five or fewer points.

KEEP IT UNDER 70

UND was an impressive 15-1 when holding its opponent under 70 points. In Coach Brewster's five-year tenure, North Dakota is 74-25 (.747) when keeping the opponent under 70 and 63-15 (.808) the past four seasons.

GET OUTTA HERE

North Dakota's Samantha Roscoe finished second in the final Big Sky Conference rankings with 1.7 blocks/game (50), followed by Lexi Klabo at 1.5 in third (46).

WEST COAST COMEBACKS

UND won both of its non-conference games against West Coast Conference teams, needing comebacks to achieve each victory. North Dakota rallied back from an 11-point, third-quarter deficit in its most recent win at San Diego. On Dec. 6, UND came all the back from down 13 in the third quarter as well before a 71-63 win.

SAVE THE BEST FOR LAST

In UND's Jan. 7 win at Southern Utah, the Fighting Hawks were able to rally back from down 16 by outscoring the Thunderbirds, 26-9, in the final quarter for a 68-63 win. Makailah Dyer had 17 of her game-high 20 in that final frame alone.

JANUARY JUBILANCE

Coach Brewster's teams also crank it to another level when the calendar turns to a new year. In the month of January, his teams are now 29-14 (.674) combined. This year, UND was 7-1 in the first month of the year.

DECEMBER TO REMEMBER

UND pieced together its winningest December in its NCAA Division I era with a 6-2 mark. North Dakota's six wins were two more than any other UND team could produce. Coach Travis Brewster has chalked up a 20-12 (.625) record in his five seasons at the helm.

NEW SCHOOL MARK FOR FREE THROWS

Senior Makailah Dyer connected on all 14 of her free throw attempts Dec. 18 at Northern Iowa to set a new school record for free throw makes without a miss in a single game. She broke Kristi Boese's record (13-13) in the first game played in the Betty Engelstad Sioux Center (Nov. 15, 2004).

EIGHT IS ENOUGH?

Head coach **Travis Brewster** nabbed his eighth wins against both Weber State and Idaho State this season, tied for the most against any one school.
