IN THE PAINT...

- North Dakota will take its three-game winning streak on the road where the Fighting Hawks will commence their Treasure State swing at Montana State on Thursday. Tip-off against the Bobcats is set for 8:05 p.m. CT.
- UND had defeated the Bobcats in each of their first three meetings as a Big Sky member in Worthington Arena before MSU snapped that streak with an 89-82 in last season's regular-season finale. The Fighting Hawks are 7-5 all-time in Bozeman and own a 12-11 edge in the all-time series.
- The Bobcats' victory last season marked the first time the Fighting Hawks were swept on the road by both Montana programs since joining the Big Sky. UND has yet to pick up the Montana sweep, however, going 0-4 at Dahlberg Arena.
- After dropping its league opener at Portland State (Dec. 29), UND has equaled its best winning streak of the season with three straight victories. The Fighting Hawks' last four-game winning streak came occurred in Big Sky play during the 2013-14 season.
- UND improved to 5-1 at home this season with its 95-65 rout of Southern Utah on Saturday. The Fighting Hawks are now 5-0 when scoring 90 or more points and are averaging 87.7 ppg at "The Betty" this season.
- UND arrives in Bozeman with a 2-4 record on the road and 1-1 mark in league road games after splitting at Portland State (L) and Sacramento State (W) to open Big Sky play.
- Senior **Quinton Hooker** scored a season-high 31 points in UND's last road contest, which was a 90-82 overtime win at Sacramento State on New Year's Eve.

OPPONENT PREVIEW: MONTANA STATE

- Third-year Montana State head coach **Brian Fish** has the Bobcats off to a 6-11 start and 1-3 tally in Big Sky play this season. Montana State is second in the league in scoring at 80.3 ppg, but second-to-last in scoring defense, yielding 80.6 ppg.
- Sophomore **Tyler Hall** provides a bulk of the team's scoring and ranks third nationally at 23.4 ppg. He has reached double figures in 16 of the Bobcats' 17 games this season. Hall scored a career-high 42 points in an 83-78 loss to Milwaukee and has back-to-back 30-point contests entering the week. UND limited the high-scoring sophomore to 11.5 ppg in last year's split.
- The latter was a 32-point outing at Idaho (Jan. 7), but the Vandals were able to deal MSU an 83-81 overtime setback. It was the Bobcats' ninth loss in their last 10 games. He had 33 points in a loss at EWU (Jan. 5).
- The lone win was an 80-63 triumph over Idaho State on New Year's at Worthington Arena where the Bobcats are 6-4 on the season (0-7 road). MSU is averaging 84.5 ppg on its home court.
- Hall's backcourt mate **Hayden Frey** is the top scoring freshman in the Big Sky as the Norway native is averaging 11.6 ppg in his first collegiate season. Frey has upped that average to 14.8 ppg in Big Sky play and is connecting on 66.7 percent of his treys in league action (14-for-21).
- **Quinton Everett** gives the Bobcats a trio of double-figure scorers in league play. He has provided his scoring punch off the bench in those games after starting 12 of the team's 13 non-conference games. He's averaging 10.2 ppg overall and 11.8 ppg in league action.
- Guard **Zach Green** averaged 12.8 ppg in non-conference play for the Bobcats, but is scoring only 5.5 ppg in league action. He scored a career-high 23 points in MSU's home win over UND in the regular season finale.
- The Bobcats saw their tallest player return to the court at Idaho when Sarp Gobeloglu, a 6-foot-10 forward, logged nine minutes after sitting out the last five games.

ON THE HORIZON

UND wraps up the Treasure State swing with a Saturday night tilt against Montana at Dahlberg Arena. The Grizzlies have won four straight in the series and own a 10-1 record against UND at home. Tip-off is slated for 8:05 p.m. CT.

LAST TIME OUT: UND 95, Southern Utah 65 (Jan. 7)

GRAND FORKS, N.D. – Senior Quinton Hooker led six Fighting Hawks in double figures with 23 points as North Dakota routed Southern Utah 95-65 Saturday in Big Sky play. Sophomore Josh Collins, who earned his first career start in place of an injured Drick Bernstine, chipped in with career-highs in points (11) and rebounds (7) to help UND (8-6, 3-1 BSC) to its third straight win.

UND would end up shooting 53 percent from the floor, while holding the Thunderbirds (4-12, 2-1 BSC) to just a season-low 25.9 percent effort. The Fighting Hawks also held the league's top scorer Randy Onwuasor to 19 points on a 6-for-19 effort from the field. Onwuasor's teammates combined to make just nine other field goals in the contest as the visitors never led.

Sophomore Geno Crandall added 13 points and a career-high nine assists. Both he and Hooker had 11 first-half points to help the home team build a 43-25 lead at the break.

CLOSING IN ON THE TOP 10

With his sixth 20-plus point game of the season, senior **Quinton Hooker** is now 14 points away from moving into UND's top 10 list for all-time scoring. He currently sits in 12th and moved within a point of tying former teammate **Aaron Anderson** for 11th place (1,430; 2010-14). Chris Fahbrach holds down the 10th spot with 1,442 points during his UND career from 1975-1979.

THE ONE AND ONLY

Senior **Quinton Hooker** is the only player in program history to score 1,400 points (1,429), grab 400 rebounds (413), dish out 300 assists (349) and net 150 steals (158) in a career. He is second among active Big Sky scorer's trailing only Weber State's Jeremy Senglin (1,624). His 158 steals are tops among league players.

HOOKER COLLECTS BIG SKY PLAYER OF THE WEEK AWARD

Senior **Quinton Hooker** collected his first Big Sky Player of the Week award and third of his career on Monday after leading the Fighting Hawks to pair of home wins over Northern Arizona (68-63; Jan. 5) and Southern Utah (95-65; Jan. 7). He averaged 21.5 ppg, 6.5 rpg and 4.0 apg in those two victories and is averaging 24.6 ppg during UND's three-game winning streak.

EXTRA INSIGHT ...

- Sophomore **Conner Avants** posted his eighth double-figure scoring game of the season (sixth in the past seven games) in the win over Southern Utah. Avants also had two blocks for the second-straight game after collecting just two rejections in UND's first 12 contests.
- Sophomore **Geno Crandall** is averaging a career-best 12.2 ppg and has reached double figures in 10 of 13 contests this season. He had a career-high 24 points in the road win at NDSU (Dec. 7). Crandall had 13 points and a career-high nine assists in the win over SUU. He has 14 helpers and only four turnovers during UND's three-game winning streak.
- Senior **Corey Baldwin** connected on a season-high four 3-pointers and has reached double figures in each of UND's three-straight victories. He's averaging 12.0 ppg over the span.
- Junior **Drick Bernstine** missed his first game in a UND uniform Saturday against Southern Utah (Jan. 7). The 6-foot-8 forward had started his first 46 games before sitting out against the Thunderbirds. He is the only Big Sky player to rank among the top 10 in rebounding (4th; 7.8 rpg) and assists (9th; 3.8 apg).
- Sophomore **Josh Collins** started in place of Bernstine against SUU and logged career-highs in points (11), field goals (5), rebounds (7) and assists. It was Collins' first career start and second career double-figure scoring game.
- Freshman **Kienan Walter** also posted a career-high with 10 points against the T-Birds. Walter has appeared in three Big Sky games and is averaging 6.0 ppg and shooting 70 percent from the floor in league action.
- The Fighting Hawks improved to 7-3 all-time on New Year's Eve with the eight-point, overtime win at Sacramento State.



HEAD COACH BRIAN JONES



Head coach Brian Jones is entering his 11th season at the helm of the North Dakota men's basketball program. Jones will look to keep UND at the top of the Big Sky. The Fighting Hawks own three top-five finishes during their first four years as a league member. UND finished third in 2012-13, tied for second in 2013-14 and tied for fifth in 2015-16. In its three Big Sky postseason tournaments, UND has made runs to the semifinals in 2013 and 2016 and advanced to the title game in 2014. Jones has also guided his team to five CollegelInsider.com Postseason Tournaments in

the past six seasons. He also led UND to Great West Conference Tournament titles in 2011 and 2012.

- Sophomore **Cortez Seales** is now 5-for-11 on the season from deep (45.5 percent) after going only 6-for-26 from beyond the arc as a freshman (23.1 percent). In fact, Seales started this season 0-for-5, but has made 5-of-6 over the last six games.
- UND's 37-point loss to Portland State was the largest for the program in a Big Sky contest in four-plus seasons as a league member. It was only the fifth 20-plus point setback in 39 all-time league losses. The worst previous defeat was a 95-63 loss to Weber State during UND's first season in the league.
- Junior forward **Solomon Rolls-Tyson** left the program during the Holiday break to pursue a professional career in Norway. Rolls-Tyson transferred to UND from Utah State Eastern this past summer and was redshirting.
- Junior **Carson Shanks** scored a career-high 17 points in 17 minutes of action at Northern Iowa (Dec. 10). Shanks went 8-for-10 from the floor against the Panthers. Shanks is averaging a career-best 7.2 ppg in 13 games off the bench this season.
- After being held to a season-low four points at NDSU (Dec. 7), senior **Quinton Hooker** responded with a team-high 22 points at Northern Iowa (Dec. 10). Hooker was held to single digits just twice last season as a junior in 32 games. One of those was a four-point outing at Montana and he responded with 25 points in the next game at Montana State.
- UND's eight-point loss to the Panthers was a 38-point improvement from last season's 97-51 loss to UNI at home. The Fighting Hawks trailed 54-20 at halftime of that contest and led the Panthers 33-29 this year.
- Hooker was named to the Men Against Breast Cancer Classic All-Tournament team after averaging 18.7 ppg during the team's three games at the Nutter Center in Dayton, Ohio. Hooker's 29-point outing in the opener vs. North Florida was one shy of his season high of 30 set in the win over Mayville State (Nov. 15).
- The Fighting Hawks averaged 97.7 ppg during their three-game, season-opening homestand and became the first UND team to reach the 90-plus point plateau in three straight since Rich Glas' 1993-94 squad that cracked the century mark in wins over Dakota State (100-76), Nebraska-Kearney (103-96, ot) and Valley City State (102-63).

TOUGH SLEDDING

All three of UND's opponents at the MABC Classic in Dayton won 20-plus games a season ago. Cal State-Bakersfield participated in the NCAA Tournament, while North Florida was the Atlantic Sun regular season champion and played in the NIT. In fact, UND's seven Division I non-conference games were all against teams that reached the 20-win plateau a season ago. Five of those teams participated in postseason play. Northern Iowa and Iowa both won a game in the 2016 NCAA Tournament before bowing out in the round of 32. The Panthers loss to Oklahoma in a game that featured a frantic comeback by the Sooners, while the Hawkeyes fell to eventual National Champion Villanova 87-68.

CAPTAIN HOOKER

For the second-consecutive season, senior **Quinton Hooker** will serve as a team captain. He is joined in his captaincy by junior **Drick Bernstine**, who was the only Fighting Hawk to start all 33 games last season.

HOOKER NAMED BIG SKY PRESEASON MVP

North Dakota senior **Quinton Hooker** was named the Big Sky Preseason MVP on Oct. 26 in an announcement made by league officials. Hooker was one of six guards voted to the Big Sky Preseason All-Conference Team by media members after averaging 20.1 ppg and leading the Fighting Hawks to a nine-win improvement as a junior. The Lou Henson Mid-Major All-American increased his scoring average to 20.6 ppg in Big Sky play and scored 20-plus points in 15 games overall and 30-plus points on four different occasions last season. The first team All-Big Sky performer was also the first Fighting Hawk to average 20-plus points since the program moved to the Division I level (2008-09) and his pair of 38-point performances are also single-game highs at the DI level.

GRAND FORKS -- Freshman Geno Crandall scored a game-high 18 points to lead North Dakota to an 85-68 victory over Montana State in Big Sky men's basketball action.

Crandall also dished out a career-high seven assists as UND (8-8, 3-2 BSC) shot 58 percent from the floor to move back to the .500 mark for the first time since early in the season (2-2).

Defensively, the Bobcats (7-10, 2-3 BSC) managed to knock down only 39 percent of their field goals and had 19 turnovers that UND converted into 23 points.

Junior Quinton Hooker added 17 points and a season-high eight assists for the home team, who dished out a season-high 19 helpers on 33 made field goals.

Junior Corey Baldwin added 13 points and Cortez Seales chipped in with 12 to round out a quartet of double-figure scorers for the home team.

BOZEMAN -- Montana State had to hold off a late rally by North Dakota, but the Bobcats were able to upend the Fighting Hawks 89-82 in the Big Sky regular-season finale for both teams.

The Bobcats (14-16, 9-9 BSC) got a boost from Marcus Colbert, who was playing his final game on his home court, as the senior scored 29 points to lead all scorers. Montana State also got a career-high 23 points from Zach Green as those efforts helped combat 25 points from Quinton Hooker.

UND's high-scoring junior had 19 of his points after halftime as the Fighting Hawks (15-14, 10-8 BSC) trimmed what at one point was a 15-point deficit all the way down to five in the closing stretch. Freshman Geno Crandall, who added 15 points for the visitors, aided in that comeback with 11 second-half points.

The victory was the first for the Bobcats over UND at home since the Fighting Hawks joined the league prior to the 2012-13 season.

ROSTER ROUND-UP

- Senior **Quinton Hooker** returns to the backcourt after racking up Lou Henson Mid-Major All-America honors and All-Big Sky first team accolades. He was also named to the College Sports Report Mid-Major Player of the Year via fan vote.
- As a junior, Hooker was third in the league in scoring at 20.1 ppg and earned Big Sky All-Tournament honors as well after averaging 27.0 ppg in three games in Reno.
- He reached double figures 30 times, including four 30-plus point scoring outputs. Hooker set UND's DI single-game scoring mark with 38 points in a win vs. Portland State and matched that in the semifinal loss to Weber State in Reno. Hooker's not only adept at scoring as he also ranked second on the team in assists (112/3.5 apg), rebounds (156/4.9 rpg) and steals (60/1.9 spg).
- Junior **Drick Bernstine** was the only Fighting Hawk to start all 33 games a season ago. The Denver transfer was third on the team in scoring at 9.7 ppg and led the team and ranked third in the Big Sky in rebounding at 9.1 rpg. His 299 total rebounds were a UND Division I single-season record. He recorded his ninth double-double in the win over Idaho State in Reno, setting the Big Sky Tournament single-game record with 21 boards.
- Sophomore **Geno Crandall** earned 27 starts at point guard in his rookie season and ranked sixth in the Big Sky in assists (129/4.2 apg). He also chipped in with 10.8 ppg (second on the team) and went 6-for-6 from beyond the arc in his collegiate debut at Wisconsin.
- Sophomore **Carson Shanks** is back after starting 24 games and appearing in 31 during his first full-season at UND. He averaged 5.5 ppg and 3.3 rpg and had a career-high 16 points in the win at Idaho State (Jan. 9). Shanks also had an 11-point, season-high nine rebound effort in the Big Sky Semifinals vs. Weber State.
- Rounding out the five returning starters is guard **Corey Baldwin**, who averaged 7.8 ppg in his first Division I season. He reached double figures 13 times and had 20-plus point performances in road wins at Bradley (20) and Idaho State (22).
- Sophomores **Conner Avants** (6.8 ppg; 3.2 rpg) and **Cortez Seales** (7.5 ppg; 2.1 rpg) provided a scoring punch off the bench last season. Both players had 10 double-digit scoring games as true freshmen. Classmate **Josh Collins** saw spot duty a season ago and had a season-high seven points vs. Minnesota-Morris and chipped in with six points in 20 minutes of action at Kansas State.
- Walk-on **Thomas Blake** returns for his fifth season. Blake has appeared in 18 total games over the last three seasons.
- Jones has five newcomers to potentially mix into his rotation this season, while Creighton transfer **Marlon Stewart** will have to sit out due to NCAA transfer rules. Stewart and Seales were prep teammates together at North Scott, leading the Lancers to their first state title in 2015.
- Those eligible to play right away include JUCO transfer **Jafar Kinsey** (Des Moines Area C.C.). He is a 6-foot-2 guard that started his collegiate career at Robert Morris before averaging 17.2 ppg and 5.5 rpg at the JUCO level last season. Jones announced prior to the season that Kinsey will redshirt in 2016-17.
- Forward **Devon Pekas** spent the 2013-14 season playing at Liberty in the Atlantic Sun Conference, but has only been a student at UND for the past two seasons. He was invited to walk-on to the Fighting Hawks' roster and the 6-foot-4 forward will be a senior this season.
- Jones also has a pair of true freshmen on his roster that he announced will play during the 2016-17 season. **Billy Brown** will provide back-court depth after earning Iowa Newspaper Association all-state second team honors as a senior (21.7 ppg, fourth in Iowa Class 3A). **Kienan Walter** is another 6-foot-8 newcomer that can stretch the floor with his shooting ability. He earned Washington Class 1A all-state honors as a junior and senior. Walter led all Class 1A in scoring as a junior (23.6 ppg) and added 22.0 ppg as a senior en route to Trico League MVP honors.

NICKNAME HISTORY

The University of North Dakota boasts a proud history of varsity athletics nicknames. UND's first official athletics nickname was the "Flickertails," although its origin remains somewhat a mystery. The nickname made its first public appearance in a Grand Forks Herald account of UND's football loss to Minnesota on Oct. 8, 1904, 15 years after UND's first athletics contest was played. According to Lee Bohnet's A Century of UND Sports, "The author was not identified, but there is strong evidence the nickname was coined by a Minneapolis sportswriter who may have covered the game for the Herald. The writer lauded the fighting spirit of the North Dakota players."

In 1911, UND's student body officially adopted "Flickertails" as its athletics nickname. UND would remain known as the "Flickertails" (as well, unofficially, as the "Nodaks") for a third of a century, establishing an early athletics history.

In the fall of 1930, the university adopted the nickname "Sioux" for its varsity teams following a successful renaming campaign by the Dakota Student, UND's student newspaper. The word "Fighting" was later added, and UND would be known as the "Fighting Sioux" until the summer of 2012.

The university utilized several "Fighting Sioux" logos throughout the decades, perhaps most notably the green geometric logo introduced in 1976 and the most recent full-color logo was unveiled in 1999. The former was designed by an artist at the UND News Bureau, while the latter was created by noted Native American artist and UND alum Bennett Brien.

The University of North Dakota officially retired its longtime "Fighting Sioux" nickname and logo prior to the 2012-13 athletics season.

UND's varsity athletics teams operated without an official nickname, while the university continued the process of adopting the third official nickname in school history last fall. During that time, the university's varsity athletics teams will continue to be referred to as "the University of North Dakota," "North Dakota," or "UND."

Former President Dr. Robert Kelley announced in mid-November that "Fighting Hawks" would be the University's new moniker and the UND football team played under that nickname in its 2015 season finale at Cal Poly -- a 45-21 victory over the Mustangs.

2015-16 SEASON REWIND

HARDWARE HOOKER

Junior **Quinton Hooker** put together one of the best individual seasons of the program's Division I era. He was the first player to average 20-plus points, pouring in 20.1 ppg in 32 contests. The last UND player to average 20-plus points in a campaign **Jerome Beasley**, who scored at a 26.7 ppg clip in 2002-03.

Hooker reached double figures 30 times during the season and set UND's Division I single-game scoring mark twice with a pair of 38-point performances. He had four, 30-plus point scoring games.

For his efforts, Hooker also collected a number of accolades:

THE BERNSTINE BOARDS

Sophomore **Drick Bernstine** put together an impressive first campaign at UND in 2015-16. He set UND Division I records for double-doubles in a season with nine and set the overall mark by finishing the year with 299. That was 68 more than the previous mark held by **Troy Huff**, who had 231 during his senior season in 2013-14.

The Denver transfer nearly broke the Big Sky Tournament record with 38 total rebounds in three games in Reno (record is 40), but did set the single-game tournament mark with 21 against Idaho State (also a UND DI single-game record).

The Aurora, Colo., native averaged a double-double during UND's run to the Big Sky Tournament semifinals, scoring 11.7 ppg and adding 12.7 rpg in Reno. He finished his first season at UND with 9.7 ppg and 9.1 rpg averages.

CROOKED CRANDALL

Redshirt freshman **Geno Crandall** proved to be a matchup nightmare on both ends of the court for Big Sky opponents during his first collegiate season. Not only did the rookie average 10.8 ppg (second-best on the team), but he also dished out a team-high 129 assists (4.7/g) and ranked among the league leaders in steals, swiping 59 on the season (t-8th most in a single season at UND). Crandall closed out his first year with his best overall game in the overtime loss to UC Irvine in the CIT. He notched season-highs in points (22), assists (8) and rebounds (7) against the Anteaters.

TOUGH OUT

UND has appeared in the Big Sky Tournament in three of its four seasons as a league member and advanced to at least the semifinals in each of those trips. In the first neutral site tournament in league history a year ago, the fifth-seeded Fighting Hawks took top-seed and eventual champion Weber State to overtime before the Wildcats prevailed 83-78. In fact, Weber State is the only team to beat UND in the Big Sky Tourna-

ment. The Fighting Hawks are 5-0 in their other tournament tilts.

BACK TO THE CIT

UND capped its 2015-16 season by playing in the CIT for the fifth time in the last six years. The 89-86 overtime loss to eventual runner-up UC Irvine was the program's first postseason home game since moving to the Division I level.

MORE THAN DOUBLED-UP

With two wins in the 2016 Big Sky Tournament, UND more than doubled its win total from the previous year, finishing with 17 on the campaign. The nine-win improvement was among the tops in the country and is the second-best improvement from one season to the next in head coach **Brian Jones'** tenure at UND. His 2010-11 squad finished with a 19-15 record after the 2009-10 squad managed just an 8-23 record.

BAREFOOT COACH OF THE YEAR

Head coach **Brian Jones** was named the 2016 Samaritan's Feet Barefoot Coach of the Year and was presented the annual award at the Legends of the Hardwood Breakfast in conjunction with last year's Final Four. Jones has coached a game barefoot during each of the last four seasons to help create awareness for the Samaritan's Feet cause and his teams have participated in local shoe drives where the players and staff distribute new shoes and wash the feet of those in need.

HE DID WHAT?

Here's a look at some of the top individual performances by the cast of Fighting Hawks throughout the 2015-16 season:

- Junior **Quinton Hooker** registered the first known triple-double in UND history with a 13-point, 12-rebound and 10-assist performance in a February home win over Idaho State. The 12 rebounds were a career-high for the 6-foot-0 guard.
- Hooker had a pair of 30-point performances in the Big Sky Tournament, finishing the three-game by averaging 27.0 ppg in Reno. He equaled his career-high with 38 points in the semifinal loss to Weber State.
- Junior **Corey Baldwin** hit five 3-pointers in a game twice during the season, scoring 22 points in what turned out to be a pair of wins for UND. He also had a 20-point effort in the double-overtime win at Bradley.
- Freshman **Adam McDermott** knocked down eight 3-pointers en route to a season-high 28 points in a home win over Idaho State. His eighth trifecta was the

10th assist of the night for Hooker, giving him the triple-double.

- Junior **Drick Bernstine** was a double-double machine, racking up nine during the season, but it was his 14-point, 21-rebound outburst against Idaho State in the Big Sky Tournament that helped UND crush the Bengals 83-49. The 34-point victory was the largest in the 42-year history of the Big Sky Tournament.

- Freshman **Geno Crandall** made his collegiate debut at Big Ten-power and reigning National runner-up Wisconsin. He came off the bench against the Badgers and buried all six of his treys to finish with 19 points.

- Freshman **Conner Avants** scored 12 points and grabbed five rebounds off the bench in UND's first victory over Weber State in eight previous tries. Avants finished his rookie season with nine double-digit scoring efforts.

- Sophomore **Carson Shanks** scored a season-high 16 points on 7-of-9 shooting from the floor in UND's 84-76 victory over Idaho State. UND would go on to beat the Bengals two more times during the season and improve to 7-0 all-time against ISU.

PRESEASON POLLS

OGDEN, Utah – The North Dakota men's basketball team was picked third in the Big Sky Coaches' preseason poll and fourth in the Big Sky Media preseason poll that were released by league officials on Friday. The coaches and media both selected Weber State to repeat as league champion.

The Fighting Hawks received three first-place votes and finished with 103 points in the coaches' poll. UND was only one point behind Idaho (104), who received one first place vote among the coaches.

In the media poll, Montana wound up in second behind the Wildcats and picked up three-first place votes. The Griz were fourth in the coaches' poll. Idaho was third (158; two first-place votes), while UND was fourth had 137 points and picked up one first-place vote.

11th-year head coach Brian Jones has all five starters and seven of his top eight scorers back from a 2015-16 squad that posted a 17-16 overall record and advanced to the CollegenInsider.com Post-season Tournament for the fifth time in six seasons.

"It's going to be a very exciting year in the Big Sky and a very challenging one. The top five teams in these polls have a lot of their key contributors back," Jones said. "That is going to make this league as tough as it has been since we've been it.

"We're grateful though to be lumped in there with that top grouping, but we all know it's how you produce on the court that matters and that will be our focus. We'll have to play with these expectations and being able to handle them will be a nice challenge for our young group."
