I KEEP ON FALL-IN

Junior Fallyn Freije stormed out of the gates in the loss at eighth-ranked Baylor. The Edmore, N.D., product had 10 of North Dakota's first 13 points as the Fighting Hawks led 13-9 midway through the opening frame in Waco, Texas.

RPI RAMBLINGS

LAST TIME OUT

UND led 13-9 at eighth-ranked Baylor, but the national-power Lady Bears responded, eventually taking a 105-43 win Tuesday evening in Waco, Texas. Junior Fallyn Freije scored 10 of UND's first 13 points en route to a team-high 13 points for the game.

THAT'S PRETTY, PRETTY GOOD

Baylor's win Tuesday was pretty run of the mill. In fact, the Lady Bears extended their streak of wins over unranked non-conference teams at home to 182 straight. That stretch dates all the way back to 2003.

ONLY GAVE UP TWO TOUCHDOWNS

UND squandered just 14 first-half points to UTSA in the Nov. 25 win. That total was the fewest allowed in a half for North Dakota since an 88-40 win over Dickinson State on Dec. 2, 2014 that saw just 13 second-half points for DSU.

10-MINUTE MADNESS

North Dakota held UTSA scoreless for a whopping 10:42 in the Nov. 25 win. The Roadrunners scored with just under seven minutes to go to make it 19-14, didn't see the scoreboard move until near four minutes were gone in the third quarter and the Hawks had piled up a 36-14 lead.

COMEBACK KIDS

The Fighting Hawks trailed by 15 with 8:15 left in the third quarter vs. Lamar on Nov. 24 but rallied to win, 73-70. UND was down 13 at the break with 21 turnovers but managed to right the ship and out-score the Cardinals, 23-11 in the third quarter on the way to the win.

PICKIN' ON THE PANTHERS

Lexi Klabo scored a career-high 29 points in the win over Northern Iowa Dec. 2. She added 15 rebounds and seven blocked shots in the win for her ninth career double-double.

HONORS ROLL IN

Klabo was named the Big Sky Conference's Player of the Week for her performances in week two of the season. She was also the CollegeSportsMadness.com league player of the week honoree after a pair of double-doubles. She averaged 22.5 points, 12.5 rebounds and 5.5 blocks in games at South Dakota State and against UMass.

REJECTION IS ROUGH

Klabo blocked a career-high eight shots in the win over UMass Nov. 19. That total was the highest single-game total since Jenny Crouse blocked eight shots at North Dakota State Jan. 30, 1999. Crouse is the school's leading scorer, rebounder and shot blocker all-time, leading UND to three NCAA Division II championships (1997-99).

REMEMBER THE SABBATH

UND's 82-52 win over UMass was its first on a Sunday in over four years (Nov. 17, 2013 vs. South Dakota). North Dakota had dropped eight straight Sunday tilts until the Nov. 19 win.

A-10 WIN

The Nov. 19 win over UMass was the first over an Atlantic-10 team for head coach Travis Brewster. The 30-point blowout gave UND its first win over an A-10 team since the 2011-12 season. North Dakota has played just three games against the A-10 since making the Division I transition in 2008-09.

QUICK START

Melissa Dailey, who led UND in scoring in the opener at Oregon State, got going quickly in that game. She took the opening tip to the three-point line and connected just seven seconds after the tip for a fast start to her UND career. It was one of three triples for the junior transfer on the afternoon.

ABOUT NORTH DAKOTA STATE

NDSU is 5-4 thus far this season with its most recent action an 82-79 loss to University of Texas-Rio Grande Valley Tuesday at home. The Bison have had five different leading scorers this season and average four players with nine points or more per game. Senior Taylor Thunstedt leads the pack with 10.8 points per game while Reilly Jacobson averages 10.7 per contest. Rylee Nudell and Sarah Jacobson contribute 9.6 and 9.4 points per game, respectively.

ALL-TIME VS. THE BISON

North Dakota leads the all-time series with North Dakota State, taking 45 of the 88 meetings. UND has owned the series in the Division I era, taking all five meetings.

COMMON OPPONENT

NDSU scored an 82-70 win over Massachusetts on Nov. 17 for one of its three wins over Division I schools. North Dakota blasted the Minutewomen, 82-52, two days later in Grand Forks, N.D.

DEEP IN THE HEART OF TEXAS

UND made two trips to Texas this season with a 2-0 trip at the UTSA Thanksgiving Classic followed by a Dec. 5 visit to eighth-ranked Baylor. North Dakota, since transitioning to Division I in 2008-09, has now played 12 games in Texas with an 8-4 mark in those contests.

KLABO PRESEASON ALL-BIG SKY, UND PICKED SECOND

Junior forward Lexi Klabo was named to the Big Sky Conference Preseason Team while her team was picked second by both the media and the coaches in the preseason polls. North Dakota has now been picked in the top two by the coaches in each of the last five preseason prognostications.

TAKING ON ALL COMERS

Two different schools that finished in the top 10 of the Rating Percentage Index (RPI) last season appear on UND's formidable non-conference slate. Oregon State (Nov. 10) was a 31-5 team that advanced to the NCAA Sweet 16 while national power Baylor (Dec. 5), a seven-time defending Big 12 champion, highlight the non-league lineup.

Three future Summit League foes dot the schedule as South Dakota State (Nov. 15) and South Dakota (Dec. 21), both of whom were WNIT qualifiers in 2016-17, join North Dakota State (Dec. 9) in key regional matchups.

All told, nearly half of North Dakota's non-conference schedule is against teams that were in the top 100 (5 of 11). Add Montana State once the league schedule gets underway and UND will have seven total games against top 100 teams and a total of 12 games against teams that made the postseason a year ago.

*North Dakota (4) is the only Big Sky team with an active postseason streak longer than two.

*From 2013-17, UND had the most overall wins (78), Big Sky wins (52), league road wins (21) and tied for most Big Sky regular season titles (2).

FREE TIMES EIGHT

Junior Lexi Klabo knocked down all eight of her free throw attempts in the opener at Oregon State. It marked the second-highest number of free throws she's made without a miss in her career (10-10 vs. Weber State, Feb. 18, 2017).

TOP OF THE SUMMIT

North Dakota played four Summit League teams last season and boasts an 11-5 all-time mark against that conference in Division I play. UND announced it will move to the Summit beginning with the 2018-19 season.

Two-time Big Sky Conference Coach of the Year Travis Brewster enters his sixth season at the helm at the University of North Dakota and his 15th year with the women's basketball program. Brewster has led UND to four straight postseason appearances and 89 wins in his five seasons as head coach with a myriad of program firsts along the way.

Brewster, who spent nine years as an assistant under former head coach Gene Roebuck, guided the team into the first season in the Big Sky Conference in 2012-13. Once acclimated, his teams have ascended back to their normal perch near the top of the league standings and qualifying for national postseason tournaments with regularity.

Last season, North Dakota etched 20 wins and advanced to the postseason (WNIT) for the fourth consecutive year, the only Big Sky school to make that claim. In the past four seasons, North Dakota has the most overall wins (78), most league wins (52) and most league road wins (21) en route to a pair of regular season titles in that span (2014, 2017). His 2016-17 team extended a conference road winning streak to an incredible 11 straight games and wound up with an impressive 7-2 league road record. It marked the third year in the past four that North Dakota etched the most road conference wins in the Big Sky.

In 2015-16, UND rattled off 14 wins in its final 17 games to reach the postseason for a third consecutive season. North Dakota would host its first-ever postseason game and subsequently garner its first win in the opening round of the Women's Basketball Invitational (WBI). That resilient team had rallied from a 4-10 start, and a 1-3 record in Big Sky play to finish 19-14 overall and 13-5 in league play, just a game back for second place in the regular season standings. In that mix was a rare six-game road winning streak to end the regular season.

His 2014-15 team was the first (in the Division I era) to win a national tournament game, a pair of wins at the 2014 Preseason Women's National Invitational (at Towson University). That was part of a 7-1 start to the campaign, the best start on record in UND's Division I era. UND would qualify for the Women's Basketball Invitational at season's end for its third postseason appearance in four seasons.

Brewster was named the Big Sky Conference Coach of the Year in 2013-14, guiding his team to a host of firsts and milestones in a season that will long be remembered. His second team went 22-10, 15-5 in league play and not only won a share of the Big Sky's regular season title, but earned the opportunity to host the league tournament. It did so and cruised to the tourney title and the NCAA Division I Tournament-- all of those accomplishments becoming program firsts.

Accolades rained down on the club as he mentored the league's Player of the Year (Madi Buck), Sixth Person of the Year (Emily Evers) and Newcomer of the Year (Kelsey Knox) along with a Big Sky Second Team accolade for Mia Loyd. Buck was also the school's first Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA) All-Region player and was an honorable mention All-America selection after a standout senior season.

His first season (11-18 overall) was highlighted by several monumental wins as well. The team entered its first season in the Big Sky Conference and promptly knocked off preseason favorite Idaho State on Jan. 3 for its first league win. A non-conference triumph over arch-rival North Dakota State provided the first victory in Brewster's regime, a Nov. 30 win that helped UND retain bragging rights in the first game of the series since 2004. Nearly a month later, North Dakota defeated WNIT runner-up Utah 62-56 for the school's first win over a power-5 conference school (PAC-12) since joining Division I.

The success has also come in the classroom as 33 players have earned All-Big Sky Academic honors in his five seasons. His teams are consistently among the best in the nation in combined grade point average, finishing with a 3.546 GPA in 2012-13, good for fifth-best among all NCAA Division I women's basketball teams.

During his nine years on Gene Roebuck's staff, UND won over 71 percent of its games, three regular season conference titles, five conference postseason tournament titles and helped lead the program to three winning seasons during the four-year transition to NCAA Division I status. Two players earned conference player of the year accolades, three earned All-America status and nine earned first team all-conference honors.

Brewster began his career at North Dakota as a graduate assistant coach for the men's program during the 2001-02 season, then joined the women's staff as a full-time assistant in 2002. From 2002-06, he served as recruiting coordinator and assistant coach. During those four years, the Sioux won four North Central Conference Tournament titles and consecutive NCC regular season titles in 2005 and 2006. In 2006, the team finished had a perfect regular season, won the NCC regular season and conference tournament titles and finished 34-1.

Brewster spent the 2007-08 season as an assistant coach and team travel coordinator at South Dakota State and helped guide the Jackrabbits to a 23-7 record, a Summit League regular season championship and an appearance in the Women's NIT. He spent the 2006-07 season as an assistant coach and strength and conditioning liaison at Wisconsin-Milwaukee.

Brewster returned to Coach Roebuck's staff to start the transition from NCAA Division II to Division I status in '08-09. UND went 18-11, posted a perfect 13-0 home record and won the season ending UND Spring Thaw Tournament. The next season UND won the 2010 Great West Conference regular season title and in 2012 won both the conference regular season and tournament titles en route to its first Division I postseason berth, the Women's Basketball Invitational (WBI).

As a player at the collegiate level, Brewster played two seasons at Iowa Lakes Community College ('90, '91), before moving on to Division I Charleston Southern ('92, '93). At ILCC, Brewster played on teams that went 49-12; at CSU, he was a two-time defensive MVP and team captain in 1993. After graduating Charleston Southern in 1994, he played three years of professional basketball in Europe.

His family includes his wife, Rebecca, daughter, Reganne, and sons, Drake and Kaid.
